

Spending-Cash for Florida trip

MOST trip essentials are covered by the “Florida Trip Payments” that we have charged: transportation, lodging, major meals, admission fees, taxes and gratuities.

NOT included in the trip are three meals while traveling down and three meals while traveling back. Depending on how efficient and savvy students are with their dinning card they may also need to purchase 4 meals at the parks (very pricey). This could cost anywhere from \$50 - \$100 (you know how your child eats).

Additionally, students may want extra money for snacks, souvenirs, gifts, etc...

As a parent you have a good idea about your child’s ability to handle money and make wise choices. For many we suggest that larger sums of money (and even small sums of money) be given to Mr. Jarvie for safe keeping until the student needs it. Just put it in an envelope with your child’s name and I will keep it until your child requests it. (I have had parents in the past request for me to give their child \$20 each day from the envelope). Some years I hold money for 20 students, other years no one uses this option.

I will take some extra cash that students can “borrow” if they run short. I do expect/hope to be paid back!
